How to get to the Guildhall School of Music & Drama

Tube: Barbican, Moorgate, Liverpool Street, St Paul's and Bank stations are all nearby.

Bus numbers 4, 43, 55, 76, 100 and 153 all stop nearby.

Drivers can park next door at the Barbican and there are other car parks nearby.

The main entrance is a few yards from the Barbican and is accessed from Silk Street. The building has the words Guildhall School of Music and Drama on its main wall in Silk Street. The main entrance is a few yards back from the road. The event will take place in the Lecture Recital Room (LRR), which is a few yards to the right after entering the building and will be sign-posted. You will be "signed in" when you arrive. The room we are using is a small lecture room/recital room (seating capacity about 70), so the seating is raked. If you have any mobility problems please advise us ahead of time so that we can reserve a seat for you that minimises the use of stairs.
